LOCAL RULES

1. Out of Bounds (Rule 27)

- Marked by any white posts, fence or ditch bounding the course (including the practice ground to the right of the 18th hole).
- 7th & 10th hole, any ball that crosses Abdy Rd even though it may lie on another part of the course. R & A decision 27/20.

2. Water Hazards (Rule 26)

- Water hazards are marked by yellow posts. Drop a ball behind the water hazard, keeping the point of which the original ball last crosses the margin of the water hazard directly between him/her self and the hole, with no limit to how far behind the water hazard the ball may be dropped.
- Lateral water hazards are marked by red posts.

3. Overhead Power Cables (Rule 20-5)

- A ball striking overhead power line MUST be replayed without penalty.
- When playing the 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 9th holes, the pylons, power poles and support cables are all integral parts of the course from which no relief can be taken.

4. Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24-2b)

- Public footpaths, footpaths leading to or from tees & bridges, course furniture.
- A ball within two club lengths of fixed sprinkler heads,

which is within two club lengths of the putting green - line of sight relief given.

c) Protective fences, 12th, 13th & 16th tee boxes.

5. Preservation of Young Trees (Rule 24-2)

- Staked trees, if such a tree interferes with player's stance or the area of his/her intended swing, the ball MUST be lifted, without penalty and dropped in accordance with the procedures described in the above rule.

6. Garden Areas (Rule 25-1a)

- Garden areas, and all areas marked with a white line are GUR from which play is prohibited.
- Note: Occasional flowers in grassed areas are not garden areas.

7. Wrong Putting Green (Rule 25-3)

Interference by a wrong putting green occurs when a ball is on the wrong putting green, relief must be taken without penalty, (wrong putting green includes the aprons).

8. Leaving the Course

All players are required to leave the course on completing their round on the 18th green, via the path situated at the top right hand side of the 18th green.

9. Health & Safety: Players must give way to green staff.
